Each violation needs to be written and filed **separately** with the Attorney General's office and Nicholas needs a copy to send in batch to RLI to file them all against Hill's bond. Violation dates are: April 25, May 9, May 16, May 23, June 20, June 27, July 11 and July 18, 2023

These **MUST** be printed out and signed with a black pen. Print out the corresponding Agenda for that date of violation and attach it to the Complaint form. Mail it to the 100 N Carson address for the AG (address at top of complaint form).

Send a pdf copy to Nicholas at nicholas.stjon@gmail.com to file against her bond.

She is in direct violation of the Rules of Procedure Handbook voted on and approved by the BCC in a special session on October 4, 2022 indicating that she is in violation of her Oath of Office, see below.

11.2 Use. No action taken by a member or by the Commission which is not in compliance with these rules, but which is otherwise lawful shall invalidate such member or Commission action or be deemed a violation of the oath of office, misfeasance or malfeasance.

No authority other than the County Commission may enforce these rules or rely on these rules.

Failure of the County Commission to follow any of these rules shall be considered a Commission decision to waive such rule. No notice of such waiver need be given.
